

Luvuvhu River Valley challenging five night 4x4 tour - itinerary

Day 1

You travel on your own to Awelani Lodge near Pafuri. We meet at Awelani Lodge where we camp for the night. This camp site has ablution facilities.

Day 2

We depart from the Awelani Lodge and the route takes us through a couple of traditional African Shangaan Villages, before we arrive at the foothills of the Tshamavudzi Mountain range. We enter the wild Makuya Park sector of the Great Limpopo Transfrontier Park and carefully follow the rough tracks down into the Luvuvhu River Valley to our overnight campsite on the banks of the Lambwe and Luvuvhu Rivers (no amenities).



Day 3



The early sounds of nature and the whiff of fresh coffee will undoubtedly tease you out of your tent! Depart after breakfast and follow the 4x4 tracks in a northerly direction along the Luvuvhu river. We stop for views over the Luvuvhu River and arrive at our campsite next to the Luvuvhu river. This section is challenging with loose rocks. We drive slowly not to damage tyres and vehicles.

Day 4

We will stop for lunch at Mashunda Cliffs under the shady trees that line the river bank, visit the famous "World's View" before reaching our campsite which is once again situated on the banks of the Luvuvhu River (limited ablution facilities).

Day 5

We continue our 4x4 adventure journey across the foothills of the Tshamavudzi Mountain range to the Mutale River. We visit the Luvuvhu Gorge, various view points and the Mutale Falls (potholes). We spend the last night at the Mutale Camp (a surprise awaits you).



Day 6

Depart after breakfast, and follow the 4x4 tracks to the main gate of Makuya Park and exit the park. We say goodbye to our new friends and head for home.
